

# **CCPOA CHILD SCHOLARSHIP SPECIAL CONTRIBUTION**

## **PROCEDURES FOR 2010-2011 ACADEMIC YEAR**

The Clackamas County Peace Officer's Association Child Scholarship Special Contribution consists of two memorial scholarships and one special scholarship: one (1) Jimmy Shoop Memorial Scholarship, one (1) Bill Bowman Memorial Scholarship, and one (1) Damon Coates Heroism Scholarship in the amount of \$1000.00 each. Additional scholarships of \$500.00 each will be considered on a competitive basis. No more than four (4) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded. The amounts of the scholarships may be raised by the CCPOA Executive Board. Applications must be submitted to the CCPOA office and must be postmarked no later than July 1. Scholarships will be awarded no later than August 1.

### **Rules for Participation in Scholarship Competition:**

1. Applicant must be a son, daughter, step-son, step-daughter, or adopted child of a CCPOA member in good standing at the time of the application.
2. Must have a 2.5 or better grade point average. (Must submit current grade transcripts with application.)
3. Must attend an accredited institute of higher education (one which will eventually issue an Associate's, Bachelor's, or Master's Degree) as a full-time student as defined by the institution.
4. Applicant may major in any subject, except for the two Memorial Scholarships and one Heroism Scholarship, which require a major of Law Enforcement, Criminal Justice, other Emergency Services, or other related career field as determined by the Budget Committee.
5. Applicants must apply prior to graduation from high school; or within 3 months of the end of the spring term if currently enrolled in a college or university; or prior to their 24<sup>th</sup> birthday; or within two years of separation from active duty from a component of the U.S. Military Forces, but in all cases no later than July 1.
6. Applicants who are awarded scholarships may reapply for subsequent years, but will be considered competitively with all applicants in each yearly scholarship application cycle. Scholarships will not be automatically renewed from year to year. See #5 above for application time frame.
7. Applicants cannot be older than 23 years of age.
8. Applicants must submit an essay of 500 to 700 words on their goals and objectives. An essay is still required even if applicant has received a previous CCPOA scholarship.
9. The scholarship will be paid to the CCPOA parent or guardian or directly to the registrars' office of the college or university, if requested.
10. Applicants must provide prompt notification if their choice of institute of higher learning changes prior to the beginning of the school year.
11. The scholarship will not be awarded if it results in any reduction in grant and aid awards to the student by the institution.

**The awarding of scholarships pursuant to this program is at the sole discretion of the CCPOA and the CCPOA reserves the right to award the number of scholarships that the CCPOA determines to be appropriate, and the CCPOA reserves the right to modify, amend, or discontinue this program at any time.**

**The Scholarship Program is in conformance with the CCPOA By-Laws.**
